- STEP 2: Meet with your major's academic adviser to discuss how the Entrepreneurial Studies minor coordinates with your major and to obtain your adviser's signature on the minor form.

- STEP 3: Stop by 2220 Gerdin to receive signature from Kay Palan, Assoc. Dean of the College of Business.

- STEP 4: Submit the Request for Minor form to the Ag Student Services office (23 Curtiss) for final approval and to have the minor entered on your record.
